

# CAMP OUT 2020



## TROOP 121 Camping Overnighter Nov 21-22, 2020

**Departure:** Saturday, 11/21/20 at 9:00 AM from North American Martyrs Church parking lot

**Arrival Home:** Sunday, 11/22/20 between 10 AM and Noon at North American Martyrs parking lot.

### **Details of Weekend:**

- Sleeping in tents on the grounds of the Auburn Water District pump house off of Potters Farm Rd. in Auburn. Potters Farm Rd is off of South St.
- Have breakfast before you leave on Saturday
- Have permission slips ready for Saturday morning
- Troop cooking at the site. We will be using paper plates and plastic silverware. Please bring your own water bottle and hot/cold drink cup or mug.
- Everyone needs to bring a tent or make arrangements to borrow a tent. Adults and Scout will be tenting alone in their own tents due the COVID restrictions. Family members may sleep in the same tent.
- Scouts and adults will have to pay for food.
- Bring the proper gear for a late fall weekend outdoors. Bring a warm sleeping bag or a sleeping bag and a couple of extra blankets, a ground pad, warm shoes or boots. NO open toed shoes.
- It is best to dress in layers. hats, boots, mittens and gloves (several pair are preferred), thermal underwear if you want. Bring enough warm gear to change into because clothes may get wet and you will get cold. BE PREPARED!
- Scouts and adults are more than welcome to come out any time on Saturday and spend the day and/or the night if there are conflicts with scheduled events on Saturday. Just let us know when you will arrive.
- Requirements that scouts may work on:
  - Cooking! S'Mores over the fire.
  - Camping. Add to your nights of tent camping for Camping Merit Badge.
  - Hiking
  - Knots and Lashings
  - Outdoor Tools – Bring your knives, hatchets and axes and any sharpening tools if you have them (Totin Chip - ax, knife, saws)
  - Navigation/Orienteering
  - Fire Lighting (Firem'n Chit – camp fire, stoves.)
  - Plant and animal identification.
