## COVID-19 Scout Meeting Control Plan

### Screening Process / Contact Tracing

- Each scout, leader and parent will answer pre-screening question before entering the hall. Anyone who answers yes to any question should NOT attend the meeting and immediately leave the property.
- There will be an attendance sheet for each meeting to support contact tracing requirements

### What to Bring

- Every person should bring their own chair, water bottle (with name) and hand sanitizer.
- Scouts and Leaders should bring their own pen and scout books. There will be no sharing of items.

### Social Distancing

- Every scout, leader and parent will maintain 6' of social distancing at all times
- We will limit our meetings to 25 number of attendees
- We will only allow 1 people in the bathroom at a time.
- The room will be set and designed for each attendee to keep chairs 6' apart and all in the same direction. For communication or presentations that require group interaction, chairs will be set up in a large oval shape.
- Scouts are encouraged to not carpool to and from meetings

### Hygiene Protocols

- Tissues and disposable towels are available for handwashing, proper hygiene etiquette and disinfecting surfaces, as needed
- Scouts will be taught appropriate cough and sneeze etiquette
- Scouts, Leaders and Parents will either wash hands upon entry or use hand sanitizer
- Scouts, Leaders and Parents will wash/sanitize hands when;
  - The enter the building
  - Return to the building

- Exit the bathroom
- After disinfecting or cleaning surfaces
- After emptying trash
- There will be no sharing of food or water during our meetings

### **Personal Protective Equipment**

Face coverings or disposable masks must cover the nose, chin and secure to your face. No bandanas or scarves allowed. A yowie/gaiter is acceptable.

Every scout, leader or parent will wear a mask when;

- During the entire meeting
- They enter and exit the building
- Walk around or transition from groups and / or activities
- Going to the bathroom

### **Disinfecting and Cleaning**

- Flag poles will be set up and taken down by the same person. The contact surface area will be wiped down after use.
- When safe to do so, doors and windows will be opened and remained open
