- Bring work clothes, clothes that can get dirty and stained. We are not sure exactly what we will be doing yet.
- Bring the proper gear for an early fall weekend outdoors. The days may be warm but the night get cool if not cold. Bring a warm sleeping bag or a sleeping bag and a couple of extra blankets, a ground pad, warm shoes or botts. NO open toed shoes.
- It is best to dress in layers. hats, boots, thermal underwear if you want. Bring enough to change into because clothes may get wet and you will get cold. BE PREPARED!
- Have supper before you leave on Friday.
