**Details of Weekend:**

- Have supper before you leave on Friday.
- Have permission slips ready Friday night.
- Patrol cooking at Lodge
- \$15.00 per person to pay for Lodge. Patrols will have to pay for food.
- Bring the proper gear for a winter weekend outdoors. Hopefully we will be out on the pond ice fishing and skating. If there is snow, we may also be sledding. Bring winter gear – hats, boots, mittens and gloves (several pair is preferred), thermal underwear, snow pants, sled, skates, ice fishing gear, snow shoes, etc.
- It is best to dress in layers. Bring enough winter gear to change into because clothes will get wet and you will get cold. BE PREPARED!
- Scouts and adults are more than welcome to come out any time on Saturday and spend the day and/or the night if there are conflicts with scheduled events on Friday night and/or Saturday morning. Just let us know when you will arrive.
- Requirements that scouts may work on:
  - Cooking
  - Camping
  - Outdoor Tools (Totin Chip - ax, knife, saws)
  - Navigation/Orienteering
  - Fire Lighting (Firem'n Chit – camp fire, stoves)
  - Fishing Merit Badge
  - Fun!!
