1. Meeting with Fr. Fraini, pastor of North American Martyrs and Debbie Seaman of Rev. Ralph DiOrio Children Foundation

- Foundation presenting \$7,000 donation to Boy Scout Troop 121 – North American Martyrs for use on a needed Troop Trailer and Associated expenses.
- Question for Fr. Fraini on acceptance of possibly using the old trailer on site for storage.
- Registering Name?? BSA Troop 121 – North American Martyrs?? Old one originally registered to BSA Troop 121 at a Troop members home address. Then registered in Maine under BSA Troop 121 at another Troop members Auburn address but also with a Maine legal residence (Maine corporation).
- Registration costs. Total estimated at \$400 to \$500: Sales tax approx. \$400; Title \$75 (not required if under 3,000#); Registration MA = \$20/1,000# = \$60 per year. Previous Maine registration expiring in February which if renewed equates to about \$20/year.
- Insurance is optional as liability insurance on vehicle pulling trailer applies to both vehicles but damage (due to accident, vandalism, weather, etc..) or theft is not covered without a separate insurance policy. Cost could be approx. \$300+/- per year. A tax ID number may be required.
- Trailer options such as size, steel vs aluminum. Stock is limited but prices vary from \$5,000 to \$6,000 for 6'x12' trailers. Recent Troop price quote on aluminum 6'x12' Ez-Hauler trailer came in at \$5,500 down from \$6,175.
