- Have permission slips ready Friday night. Go to the troop web site to download a copy of the permission slip.
- \$7 per scout workshop registration fee. Patrols will also have to pay for food.
- There will be a \$10 per person fee for the camp site rental.
- Patrol cooking at camp site.
- Bring the proper gear for weekend camping in the spring. "BE PREPARED"
- Scouts will be doing a lot of walking and running around during the weekend. Please bring proper shoes and clothing. (sneakers, shorts, water bottle, day pack, **COMPASS**)
- Scouts and adults are more than welcome to come out any time on Saturday and spend the day and/or the night if there are conflicts with scheduled events on Friday night and/or Saturday morning. Just let us know when you will arrive. Please be aware that the later you arrive the more orienteering you will miss.
- If you are coming out on Saturday morning please be there by 9 AM sharp.
