- **Annual Scout and Troop Registration** – The troop has recharter with the Heart of New England Council and BSA for 2023. Most families have paid the registration fees. BSA registration fees for the 2023 scout year are \$150 for each scout, \$63 for each adult leader and an optional \$15 for the Scout Life magazine.
- **QUABIN HIKE** – Sometime in April the troop will be holding a day hike at the Quabbin Reservoir for anyone and everyone who wants to get out of the house, stretch your legs and get some fresh air. Please go to the web site for more details and to sign up.
- **Bike Trip – May 5-7, 2023** – The troop will bike the 25-mile Cape Cod Rail Trail. We will be camping for the weekend in the Nickerson State Park in Brewster, MA. Sign up on the Troop web site.

- **Memorial Day Parade - Monday May 29, 2023** – Once again the troop has been invited to march in the Town's annual Memorial Day parade. Interested scouts and adults

should gather at Auburn St and Rockland Rd starting at 9:15 AM. Scouts can be picked up at Hillside Cemetery at the conclusion of the parade. All scouts and leaders should be in full Class A uniform.

- **June 2023** – We are looking into a backpacking/hiking weekend in June. Where would you like to go??
- **Bottle & Can Drive** - The troop's annual bottle & can drive will be on **Saturday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> from 9 AM to 1 PM** at the Horgan Skating Rink. Start saving your empties now.
