Details of Weekend:

- Tent camping for the weekend at Fisherman Memorial State Park in Narragansett, RI
- On Saturday we will be biking down to the ferry dock, taking the ferry over to Block Island to bike or hike on the island and returning to the main land on the ferry at the end of the day.
- Have supper before you leave on Friday.
- Have permission slips ready Friday night.
- Patrol cooking at campground.
- We will plan and map out both a bike route and a hike route on the island.
- The cost per person to pay for campground and ferry to and from Block Island will be determined. Scouts and adults will also have to pay for food.
- Bring the proper gear for a spring weekend outdoors. Everyone will need to have and use a bike helmet.
- It is best to dress in layers. Bring enough gear to change into because you will get hot and sweaty from the biking or hiking but the ferry ride to and from the island could windy and brisk. BE PREPARED!
- Requirements that scouts may work on:
 - Cooking
 - Camping
 - Cycling Merit Badge
 - Hiking Merit Badge
 - Outdoor Tools (Totin Chip ax, knife, saws)
 - Fire Lighting (Firem'n Chit camp fire, stoves)
