- Tent Camping at USMA Lake Frederick Recreation facility at 54 Lake Frederick Rd, Highland Mills, NY 10930.
- Troop cooking at camp site.

- Have permission slips ready Friday morning. Go to the troop web site to download a copy of the permission slip.
- \$50 per Scout and Adult registration fee. Everyone will also have to pay for food. Food costs for the weekend should be between \$20 to \$25 per participant. Final cost will be determined.
- Bring the proper gear for weekend camping in the early spring. Nighttime temps could be at or below freezing. Please bring extra layers just in case, a warm hat and gloves or mittens also. What to pack will be discussed at upcoming Troop meetings.
- Everyone will need to bring their class A uniform (Scout shirt, Scout pants if you have them or a pair of nicer jeans or tan or dark green pants). “BE PREPARED”
- Scouts will be busy doing a lot of walking and running around during the weekend. Please bring proper shoes and clothing including a water bottle and a day pack.
- Have lunch or bring a lunch for the ride on Friday.
